Sic Bo

Description

Ancient dice game mostly played in Asia, in Macau casinos many years ago, but today it is widespread and worldwide known. Available in the famous land-based and in the modern online casinos. The game perfectly appeals to fans of craps and roulette, as the rules are almost similar: the dice are rolled, the players bet on the outcome. Sic Bo is a game of chance without a player's decision-making input.

Rules

The main object of the game is to wager on the outcome of the three rolling dice. Different chips are used to set the bet value, or the default bet value can be used. Choose the size of the chip, place the chip on the area of the table corresponding to the wanted bet. Click the roll button to see the outcome. Multiple bets for different amounts can be made on the same roll of the dice. If the bet exceeds the maximum payout allowed, the player will receive an on-screen message about the betting limit. Rebet mode is available. All winning combinations light up after the dice roll.

Betting

While playing Sic Bo various bets can be made. There are a lot of odds and payouts, ranging from 180-to-1.

Bet	Description
Small	The total sum of the three dice is between 4 and 10. Excepting triple
Big	The total sum of the three dice is between 11 and 17. Excepting triple
Specific Triple	Betting on a specific triple such as, for example, triple 5s. The winning occurs if all three dice come up showing 5
Any Triple	Betting on any triple. The winning occurs if all three dice show the same number, regardless of the numbers
Specific Double	Betting on two specific numbers. The winning occurs if two of the three dice show the specific number the player bet on
Total	Betting on the sum of numbers of the three dice. The winning occurs if the sum of the three dice correspond to the specific total score the player bet on. For example, the bet is made on Total 10, the winning occurs with the numbers 3-2-5, with 1-3-6, or with any other combination that corresponds to the sum of 10
Two-Dice Combination	Betting on the two different specific numbers. Winning occurs if at least two of the dice correspond to the dice rolled
Single-Die	Betting on one number of the dice. Winning occurs if at least one of the dice shows the specific number the player bet on

Results

When the game round is completed winnings are displayed in the 'Win' field. Balance value increases. Each bet has various payout odds. They are printed on the Sic Bo table. The lowest payout is 1-to-1 for the small or big bets. The highest payout in online Sic Bo is 180-to-1 for a winning specific triple bet. The great variety of possible Sic Bo bets means that there are a lot of chances to win.
